Wins also for Liam Varnam and Carlo Russian plus draws for Nigel Birtwistle, Samuel Milson and Graeme Carka gave Grantham a win by $4\frac{1}{2}$ to $3\frac{1}{2}$ finishing in 7^{th} place on 3 points, consigned to remain in Division 2 next season.
