Please include your grade and the age of any players under 16 at the start of the current school year. This tournament will not be graded.

Each player will have 25 minutes on the clock to complete all moves, i.e. a game lasts a maximum of 50 minutes.

Prizes-

- The Alf Newman memorial shield and £100 for the winner
- Cash prizes for second place and third place
- Two grading prizes (dependant on entrants' grading)
- Highest score by a junior player (Under 16 on 1/9/16)
- The Nottingham Building Society Shield, awarded to the highest scoring Louth Chess Club member who has not previously won it.

In the event of a tie cash prizes will be shared. Cash prizes are dependent on the number of entries received.

Coffee, tea, squash & biscuits will be available free of charge. No other food will be provided. Parking is not permitted directly outside the venue but there are plenty of car parks and side streets close by.

Please note: In all matters concerning the tournament, the decision of the controller shall be final and binding on all players. The congress committee reserves the right to refuse any entry, although such applicants will be notified.
